

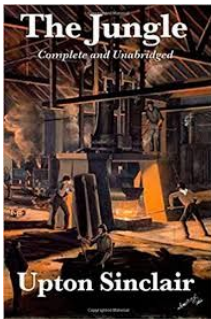

Summer Reading 2018

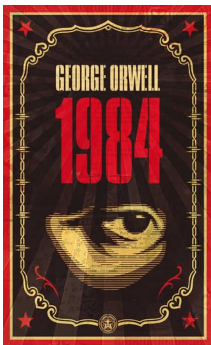

Those annotations will be assessed the first day as part of the overall summer reading assessment. We will assess these texts through the first two to three weeks of the term. Those assessments will be announced on the first day of class.

DISTRICT MISSION/PHILOSOPHY/GOALS FOR SUMMER READING

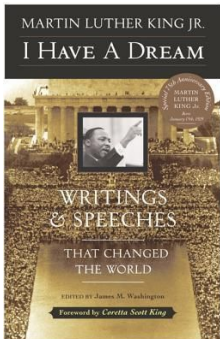
- Encourage a love of reading
